We are delighted to have Elder Lance Scout join us at our school again! Lance is a member of Kainai Nation, with strong connections to the Blackfoot Confederacy.




Our first lesson centered on The Sacred Breath and the Tobacco Ceremony, with the guiding questions of 'Who is Creator? What is Creation?'




Our second lesson centers on The Vision Quest with the guiding questions of 'What is the meaning of the Vision Quest? What am I going to learn?'

Indigenous Ways of Knowing are explored and embraced in this project which highlights the worldviews and understandings of Indigenous peoples on Turtle Island. Students gain an understanding of their own lived experiences through self-exploratory discussions and creative, practical, and collaborative assignments that reflect the student's heritage. Taught in a traditional circle space reflecting the earth, stars, moons, and our life cycle, promoting equality and belonging.
